

### Mid-Quarter Student Feedback Questionnaire

For your own sakes as well as mine, I would greatly appreciate your answers to the following open-ended questions about how this class is going. The better feedback you give me, the better teacher I'll be for the rest of the year, so it is to your advantage to put some thought into your answers. 1. How do you feel about the pace of the course? Would you prefer it go faster? Slower? Stay the same? Are there specific changes you'd like to see?
